3rd steering committee meeting of the ISEKI_Food projects, Warsaw, Poland

ISEKI FOOD QUARTERLY NEWSLETTER

The Warsaw University of Life Sciences in Poland hosted the third and final steering committee meeting of the ISEKI_Food projects from the 9th to 10th May. A total of 38 partners attended, representing 14 ISEKI_Food 3 and 7 ISEKI_Mundus 2 countries.

The meeting was opened by Professor Dorota Witrowa-Rajchert, Dean of the Faculty of Food Sciences, who gave an overview of teaching and research activities. The faculty is composed of four departments and offers full- and part-time two-stage degrees with specialisation in Biotechnology, Microbiology and Food Evaluation; Food Engineering and Process Management; and Food Technology. A tour of the facilities on the second day of the meeting demonstrated the equipment and research being conducted in these disciplines.

The meeting activities focussed on the finalisation of project activities, evaluation and reporting, as well as progress with the organisation of the ISEKI_Food 2011 conference. Abstracts have been pouring in for the various sessions and during the meeting we reached a total of over 200 received! Thanks to all the partners currently reviewing these abstracts and we look forward to a successful conference in Milan.

Many thanks to our meeting host Andrzej Lenart and his colleagues for a very enjoyable two day meeting. We were as always very well taken care of! For many of us, it was our first trip to Warsaw and I would personally recommend visiting (especially when the weather is as pleasant as we experienced!). All that remains to be said is, see you in Milan for our final meeting in August!

ISEKI_FOOD WORKSHOP ON FOOD PROFESSIONAL ETHICS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF TERAMO

An ISEKI_Food Workshop on "Professional ethics of Food Technologists" was held at the Faculty of Agriculture of the University of Teramo on 20th May.

This event was organized as part of the ISEKI_Food 3 project activities (www.iseki-food.eu) with the collaboration of the Order of Food Technologists, Regione Abruzzo (www.otaabruzzo.it) and the Association ISEKI_Food ASSOCIATION (www.Iseki-food.net).

This workshop was aimed to encourage a wide debate among food technologists, industry, students of degree courses in food science and



technology, on teaching and research ethics aspects, today more and more important, in the profession and in food production.

After the presentation of the ISEKI_Food projects given by Paola Pittia, the topic of the workshop was presented and discussed with the contributions of experts and professionals from university, professional bodies and industry, including professor Antonello Paparella, from the University of Teramo who gave an overview on food safety and ethics; dr Giancarlo Criscuoli , President of the National Board of Food technologist professionals who gave a talk titled "Professional ethics of Food technologists, from the past to the future" and dr Emiliano Di Lullo, Gruppo Amadori Industries, whom oral presentation was titled "Ethics and sustainability in the food industry".

At the event attended more than 60 participants, including professionals, representatives of food

11th INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS ON ENGINEERING AND FOOD - Food Process Engineering in a Changing World, May 22-26, 2011, ATHENS - GREECE

The ISEKI_Food Network related activities, the FP7 project TRACK_FAST and the ISEKI_Food Association were major participants in the Food Education round table at the 11th INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS ON ENGINEERING AND FOOD, held in Athens, being responsible for half of the presentations.

From TRACK_FAST, Rui Costa presented a paper "Should Academia support the regulation of professions related to food science and technology?", giving an overview of the regulated Food Science and Technology professions in Europe and asking the audience for their contribution to the discussion about common regulation of these professions in Europe.

Marco Dalla Rosa presented "Recognition of Prior Learning - a research under ISEKI_Food 3 project", introducing the concept of recognition of prior learning and summarizing the main results of the survey done within ISEKI_Food 3 and ISEKI_Mundus 2 partners institutions. The results presented showed extreme variation, from the total lack of knowledge of this kind of procedure to the recognition of complete programmes based on experiential learning of the applicant, resulting in the award of a diploma.

Finally, Iring Wasser from the Quality Assurance agency ASIIN, representing its partnership with the ISEKI_Food Association, announced to the international community the launch of the EQAS-Food Award, the accreditation scheme of Bachelor's and Master's programmes in Food Science and Technology. The ISEKI_Food projects have been working on this programme in education quality since their beginning and this Award is the culmination of many years of work and collaboration between numerous higher education institutions and industry.
